## Student Dress Code Policy

Article of Clothing	Permitted	Not Permitted
<b>Tops</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>MSJB <b>uniform</b> polo, t-shirt, long-sleeve shirt, or sweatshirt</li> <li>A solid-colored (black, gray, green, navy, white) long-sleeve shirts can be worn under MSJB t-shirts or polos</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Non-MSJB top polo, t-shirt, long sleeve, or sweatshirt</li> <li>Long sleeves under uniform tops that are not solid black, gray, green, navy, or white</li> </ul>
<b>Bottoms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Khaki or Navy bottoms: shorts, skorts, pants, jumpers</li> <li>Leggings are allowed under shorts, dresses, or skirts. Permitted colors are solid black, gray, and navy only</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tights that are not solid in color, this includes fishnet</li> <li>Sweatpants</li> <li>Leggings that are worn in place of uniform pants</li> </ul>
<b>Closed-In or Covered Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sneakers</li> <li>Comfortable boots</li> <li>Rain boots</li> </ul> <p>*Our students have a lot of outside time, please make sure they are wearing sturdy shoes for PE and other activities*</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Flip flops</li> <li>Sandals</li> <li>House shoes</li> <li>Slippers</li> <li>Crocs (classic, flip, slide, etc.)</li> </ul> <p>Note: The back strap is not equivalent to a closed in</p>
<b>Accessories</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>MSJB recommends that students wear items that are not distracting to the learning environment</li> <li>A black, brown, or navy belt is recommended</li> <li>Cardigans can be worn in class if they are solid navy or gray</li> <li>Sweaters can be worn in class if they allow visibility to the uniform top and are solid navy or gray</li> <li>Students are permitted to express themselves with fashionable socks as long as they are school appropriate and worn professionally</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bandanas</li> <li>Excessive bracelets and/or hair scrunchies on the wrist</li> <li>Sunglasses</li> <li>Head bopper/antenna headbands</li> </ul>
<b>Outerwear</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>MSJB recommends that</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hats, hoods, scarves, gloves,</li> </ul>

<p><b>General Guidelines</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shorts and skirts following the closed fist rule (the bottom of shorts or skirt should be longer than the extended arm with a clenched fist)</li> <li>• Leggings worn under full-length bottoms</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Offensive logos, images, or text</li> <li>• Large logos</li> <li>• Exposed midribs</li> <li>• Leggings that are worn as pants minus coverup</li> </ul>
